

To make Oscar the Troll, use the Woodland Troll knit pattern created by Alan Dart, found at https://www.alandart.co.uk/product/all-patterns/woodland-troll/. I have listed the yarn colors I used to more closely fit the character portrayed in the book. You will not add the hair, beard, tail, or mushroom, shown in the pattern. Additionally, to better portray the character, you will sew the nose on upside down from the original pattern so that it is hooked down rather than bent up.

Measurements

13in (33cm) tall.

Materials

Yarn

Of Silkcosy Handcrafts 50g balls; 100g Skin Color B09N3JYPQJ (for body of troll); of Red Heart Super Saver 198g balls; 22g in Spring Green E300-672 (for overalls), 6g Perfect Pink 073650016004 (for mouth and tip of nose), 2g Daffodil 1201 (For buttons); of Ice Yarns 50g balls: 8g in Cocoa Brown Eyelash 22753 (for eyebrows)

Note: Due to the smaller gauge of the Skin Color yarn (which was the only yarn I could find that most closely matched the skin tone of Oscar), I used two balls of yarn simultaneously creating knit stitches using two strands of threads together. Below, I have provided a list of alternative yarns with thicker gauges that can be used in lieu of the Skin Tone.

Alternate Yarn Options for Skin:

Of Red Heart Super Saver 198g balls; 40g Sweet Pink E400-1780 (darker and pinker than what I used) or Blushing Peach 18211961 (more orange than what I used)
